Don't forget also, that we have a big show and exhibition coming up this fall, and the time for starting work on that exhibit is NOW, and not next September when it will be too late. The 'Clothes line Exhibition' provides a wonderful opportunity to try out those ideas for arranging and mounting that you might have been wanting to try out. And, who knows, you might just be able to pick up an idea or two from another exhibit.

So, come prepared to discuss the 'Clothes Line Exhibition' and 'Mounting for Exhibition' at the February meeting, and be prepared to enter one or more of the categories at the March meeting.

CLOTHES LINE EXHIBITION RULES

1. Only ONE ALBUM PAGE (or equivalent) in any category. (No entry can be larger than a Scott's standard album page - 10" x 11½")
2. A member may enter as many different categories as he wishes.
3. Judging will be by POPULAR VOTE and a judging panel. Categories indicated by an asterisk (*) will be judged by popular vote.
4. An award will be given in each category.
5. Winning exhibits in last year's 'Clothes Line Exhibition' will not be eligible for awards. (Categories are listed on page 2)

6. Best coverage of any one stamp or set of stamps (Color - types - varieties - etc.)
7. Presentation of any country of NON POSTAGE (Such as Officials, Postage dues, Revenues, Semi-Postals, Special Delivery, etc.)
- *8. Most attractive Commercial Album Page - with contents.
- *9. Most attractive Non-commercial Album page - with contents.
- *10. Presentation of ONE Topical subject.
- *11. FOR JUNIORS ONLY - Exhibit of any country on commercial page
- *12. FOR JUNIORS ONLY - Exhibit of any country on Non-commercial page.
- *13. FOR JUNIORS ONLY - One subject of TOPICAL exhibit - any type of page.
- *14. FOR JUNIORS ONLY - Best Postal History Presentation (Appearance, contents and coverage)
