- A. Oldest full cover, showing the oldest, dated postmark.
- B. Cover with the most postal markings - front and back.
- C. Oldest picture postcard with oldest cancellation (not including Gov't postal cards).
- D. United States stamps - postal issues.
- E. Foreign Stamps - any country.
- F. Best coverage of any one stamp or set of stamps.
- G. Presentation of any country of Non-Postage items.

CLASS H thru N - judged by popular vote.

- H. Most attractive commercial page and contents.
- I. Most attractive non-commercial album page with contents.
- J. Presentation of one topical subject.
- K. For Juniors only - Exhibit of any country on a commercial page.
- L. Junior - Exhibit of any country on a non-commercial page.
- M. Junior - One Topical Subject - any type of page.
- N. Junior - Best Postal History Presentation (Appearance, contents, and coverage).
