### WHITE ELEPHANT AUCTION JUNE 10th

This month's meeting of the Quad-City Stamp Club will feature the annual White Elephant Auction of stamps and other materials. The June 10th meeting will be held at the Moline Township Hall, 620 - 18th Street, Moline, IL. The business meeting and auction will start at 8:00 PM. The hall itself will be open from seven to ten o'clock with several member/dealers in attendance.

Every year the White Elephant Auction is held to help raise money for the Club's treasury. The number one expense this money goes to cover is the rent of the Town Hall. Several members have donated items from their collection, many of these people are listed on Page 2. A partial listing of the auction lots is on Pages 5 and 6. There will more items up for grabs the evening of the Tenth, items Auction Manager Tim Kargl did not have room to list in the PHILA-QUAD.

Unlike last year, the complete auction will be held this month. The Board of Directors has decided to modify the auction procedure slightly. Beneath each lot there will be a sheet of paper. Write your bid on the sheet of paper along with your initials. If someone wishes to raise the bid, they may write the higher bid below along with their initials. This will go on until the meeting starts at eight o'clock. All lots will still be auctioned off, but the bidding will start with the highest bid on the sheet for that lot. The object of this plan is to make the auction faster by starting the bidding at a point where someone is obviously willing to pay. There will be 2 or 3 auctioneers to keep the tempo moving. The Board hopes this plan will prove successful with members. Plan to come early and look the lots over.

NATIONAL PRECANCEL STAMP CONVENTION

The National Precancel Stamp Convention will be held at the LeClaire Hotel, Moline, Ill., August 4th thru Aug. 8th, 1976. It will be hosted by the Illini Precancel Club.

There will be 24 Dealers tables, many tables for trading and an Exhibition. Meeting rooms have been reserved. A banquet has been scheduled for Saturday evening, Aug. 7th, 1976. There will be a U. S. Post Office in the main room serviced by Moline Postal Personnel and an appropriate cancellation for the convention has been approved by the post office.

The Dealers will be from all parts of the U. S. and will also bring along other material with their precancel stock. Traders will be active buying, selling and trading stamps.

For the out of town non-precancel visitors there will be many interesting places to visit in the vicinity. Many large shopping centers, the Rock Island Arsenal, Art Museums, Miami Zoo, Theaters, Sports Events and many other forms of interest are available.
