Picture Post Cards Discussed at May Meeting

While stamps are usually collected by country or topics, post cards are collected by the places or subjects pictured on the card. Pat Ryan, our speaker from the Cedar Rapids post card club, collects disaster and tragedy cards: bodies in caskets, hangings, train wrecks, etc. He told us many people collect their hometown and that one lady in Cedar Rapids has 1200 about Cedar Rapids. He said there is also interest in DPO cards. Since that is a discontinued post office, there is some tie in with philately.

We were told there is little interest in or value attached to birch bark, wooden, leather and linen cards. Canadian and German cards are popular foreign collectables. Cards by a specific designer or photographer often are valuable, particularly with an autograph.

The Club in Cedar Rapids that Pat is associated with has 47 members. They have 2 shows a year and feature the only show in Iowa to have a bourse (there are 3 other such groups in Iowa.) We hope their May show was a success and we will be looking forward to their next venture this fall.

Other Meeting News: Our election was held in accordance with our Constitution and By Laws. New officers take office immediately following the June business meeting. Virginia Lorimor won the monthly raffle. Tim Kargl, Jr. announced that the firemen's Muscular Dystrophy stamp and coin auction earned \$1500 this their first year. Illinois Postal History Society

Salvation Army - Food for Stamps

This permanent program collects world-wide used postage stamps and the money is used in the Salvation Army Bangladesh Children's Feeding Program.

It takes either 240 regular stamps, 140 commemoratives, 180 Christmas stamps or 40 foreign stamps to make one complete meal. This may sound like a lot of stamps, but so far \$7000 has been raised and for every dollar raised, 10 meals are served.

They prefer stamps with one-fourth of an inch of the envelope; off paper accepted also. Separate out foreign. Send to The Salvation Army, 401 NE Adams, Peoria, IL 61655.

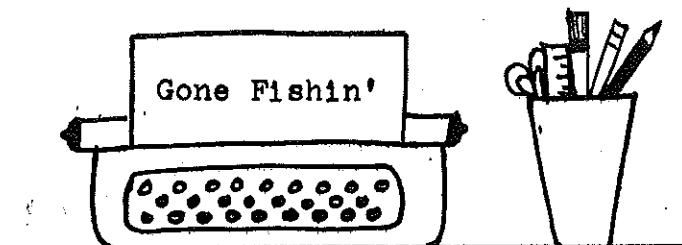
