BALD EAGLE DAY CACHET CONTEST

Darlington, WI) Valuable Heritage Collectors wish to announce cachet contest for Bald Eagle Days 1983. A twenty-five dollar cash prize will be given to the winning entry. Entry deadline will be July 1, 1983. Send entries to James Ronnerud, P.O. Box 195, Darlington, WI 53530-0195 (USA).

Bald Eagle Days 1983 is to be held on August 18, 19 and 20. Covers will be serviced on August 19. This is the first time BED's is to be held outside of the continental United States. The event will be held in Winnipeg, Manitoba CANADA.

The cachet is to be no smaller than 10 inches by 12 inches. Any suitable medium may be used, however, the cachet is to be reduced to 3 inches by 3½ inches, so subject matter may be lost in reproduction. A bold, simple design is preferable. Winning entries will be placed in the BED '83 art show to be held separately from the cachet contest.

The event's theme - "Canadian Eagles", as well as Bald Eagle Days '83, Eagle Valley Environmentalists, Inc. and Apple River, IL 61001 should be incorporated into the cachet. Bald Eagle Days '83 may be shortened to read "BED '83".

Bald Eagle Days events are sponsored by Eagle Valley Environmentalists, Inc. of Apple River, IL 61001 USA. "EVE" is the only environmental group whose sole mission is to study and protect the American Bald Eagle.
