Dues Increase for 1984

After much discussion, the Board of Directors has decided to increase membership dues in 1984. A look at the 1982 Financial statement shows income for the year as \$1,798.41, including \$363.36 profit from QUAPEX '82. The trouble is we spent \$2,139.58 for a loss of \$341.17.

The last dues increase we had was before 1975 and everyone is well aware of how costs have increased since then. Some of our fixed costs per member per year are:

November Program - CHICAGOPEX '83

CHICAGOPEX '83, the 97th annual exhibition of the Chicago Philatelic Society was held October 14 thru 16 at the Bismark Hotel in the heart of downtown Chicago. This year the event hosted the annual convention of the 1869 Pictorial Research Associates. The 200 frame exhibit included displays of 1869 stamps and covers. Michael Laurence, editor-publisher of Linn's, gave a lecture on detecting fake 1869 covers.

These and other events, such as a presentation about printing an issue of Linn's, a slide show from the 200th anniversary of balloon flight in France and a number of society meetings, will be the topic of a presentation to be given by club member Virginia Lorimor at our November meeting. We do not know what events Virginia was able to attend, but you can be sure she tried to absorb as much as she could and will pass it along to us with her usual enthusiasm.
