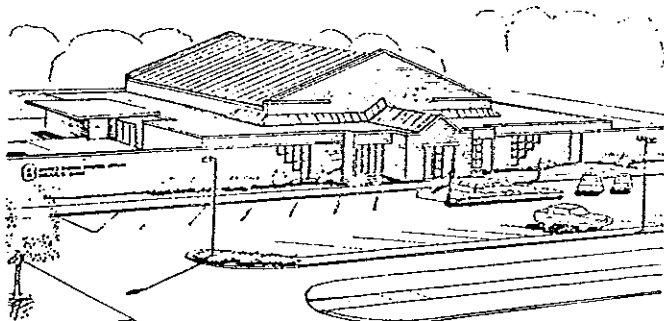
### *Illness*

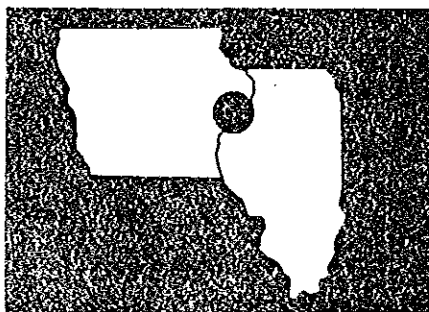
\* JUNIORS \*
