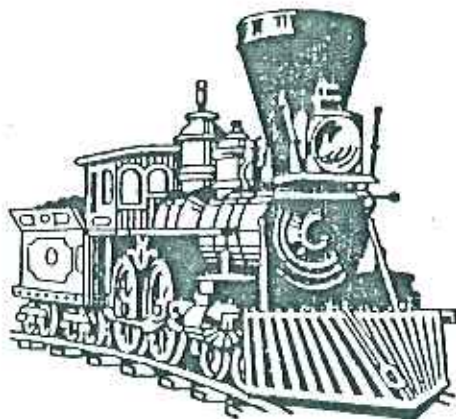


"It never rains but what it pours"

FINAL REPORT

Well, we did it. We finally topped that elusive \$50,000 mark. The man who purchased the lot that put us over that total in cash received was given a pin with the stamp shown at the right. I am going to have another pin made that reads \$100,000. I will wear it at every auction until we exceed that goal.



This year we raised \$4351.75. As auctions come and go, that was a respectable total. Eighty bidders registered. Approximately 150 US and a similar number of foreign lots were auctioned off. Over 25% of the money came from the sale of the following: US #1, 37, 112b, 163, 261a, 505, Kansas and Nebraska overprints. That total was \$1210. The highest selling item was the #37 which sold for \$300.

Representatives of Scott and Rock Island county should be on hand at the meeting to accept the checks.

We apologize for any confusion in that the money collections table was set up in such an awkward place. It turned out to be the best place under the circumstances considering the arrangement Jumer's had made for use of their rooms for the day. We will try to keep that from happening in the future.

The date of Sunday, March 12th has been selected for next year's event, so mark that on your calendars now.

The auction committee will have the tax receipts for those they expected to see at the meeting. This is a cost saving measure. See Don Hayes to pick up your receipt. Those who are not at the meeting will receive theirs by mail.
