PAST QCSC PRESIDENT WINS APS LUFF AWARD

Wilbur F. Cannon of Davenport, Iowa and Clearwater, Florida, receives the Luff Award for Outstanding Service to the American Philatelic Society.

Mr. Cannon has been an APS member since 1922, when he joined the society at age fourteen. He served as secretary of the APS in 1945 and was president of the Society from 1949-53.

Mr. Cannon became a life member of the APS only a few years after joining. His efforts while an officer were concentrated on encouraging new memberships and reaching out to existing members in the years before there was a full-time headquarters staff for member services.

Among the advances made during Mr. Cannon's presidency was the affiliation of the APS with the Philatelic Library Association and its journal, the Philatelic Literature Review. These were the forerunners of the American Philatelic Research Library and its journal. Mr. Cannon also supervised the creation of a committee to investigate the commercial stamp insurance situation in the early 1950s, a prelude to APS leadership in later years in offering low-cost stamp insurance.

Mr. Cannon also oversaw preparation of a brochure intended to introduce noncollectors to the hobby. Its four-cent price tag led to quantity purchases of the pamphlet by clubs and

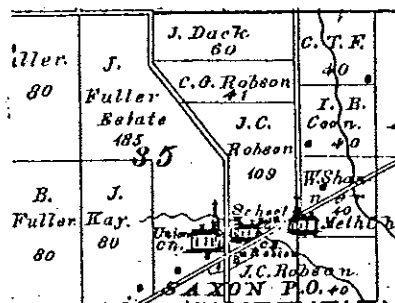
