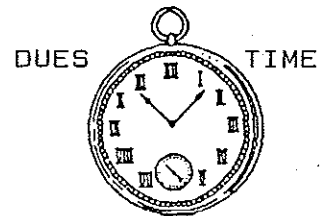

Enclosed in this issue of your newsletter you should have found a dues statement. Your dues are payable before December 31st. 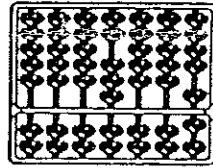

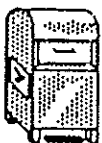
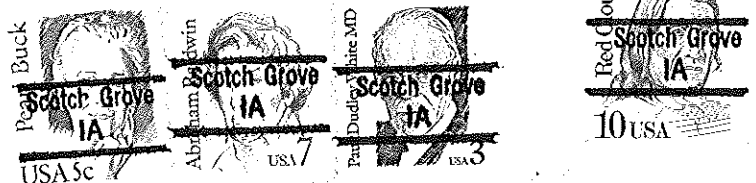
