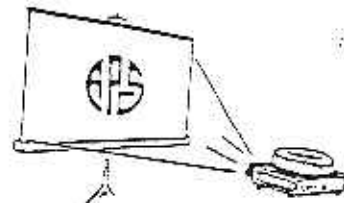

Speaking of the auction list, you will be able to pick one up at the March Club meeting.

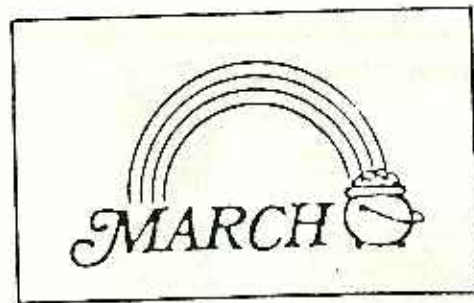

HOW TO ORDER FIRST DAY COVERS

Buy the stamp (or postal stationery item) at your local post office, affix it to an addressed envelope (postage must make up to first class rate) and send under cover to Customer-Affixed Envelopes, Postmaster, (Name of City, State and ZIP Code-9991). No remittance required.

The USPS will also affix the stamp to submitted addressed envelopes or will provide postal stationery upon request and receipt of remittance to cover cost of items. Send these requests to (Name of the issue), Postmaster, (Name of City, State and ZIP Code-9992).

The deadline for submitting envelopes for first day cancels is usually 30 days after the date of issue.

Mail orders for mint stamps, plate number, Mr. Zip and Copyright blocks, full panes and postal stationery items should be sent to Philatelic Sales Division, Washington, DC 20265-9997. The PSD imposes a \$10 minimum and 50¢ service charge on all orders. A Philatelic Sales Catalog is available free upon request from the PSD at the aforementioned address.
