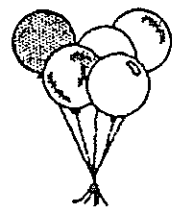

- DD. Juniors only - any area



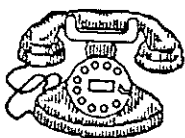
Dear QCS Member,

If damaged stamps are submitted, the lot should catalog at least \$20.00. If multiple or similar lots are submitted, some may be held over for future auctions to insure balanced auctions. Be advised that the auction manager may regroup material to make lots more saleable.
