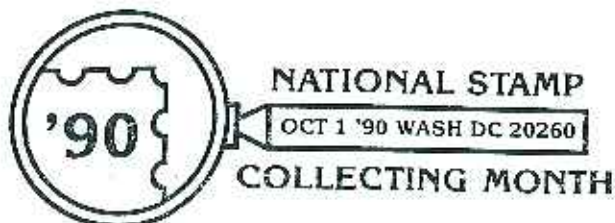
CELEBRATE STAMP COLLECTING MONTH
