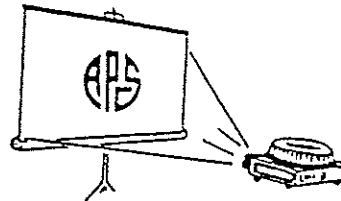

Cancer Auction Expenses

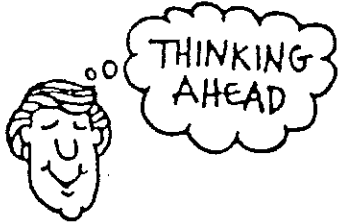

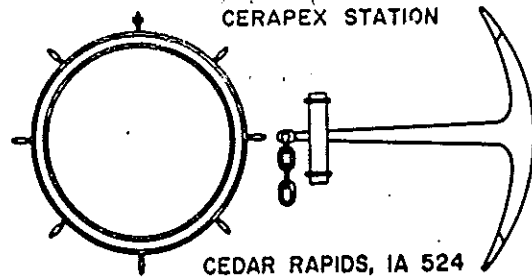

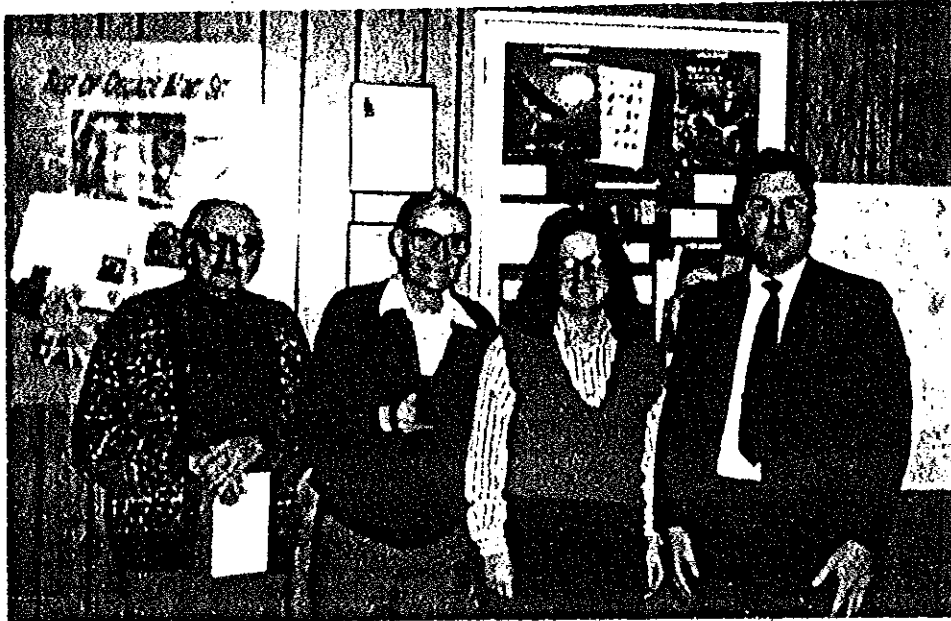
Volunteers are being sought to assist with this big event. Information will be available from the Secretary at the meeting.

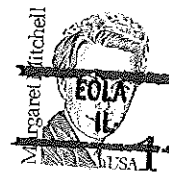
