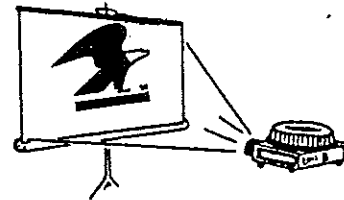

The President's Corner

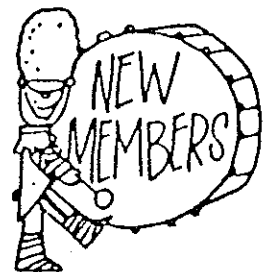

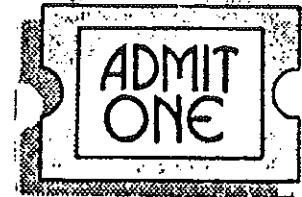

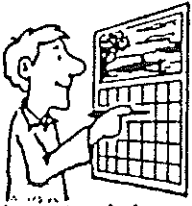
