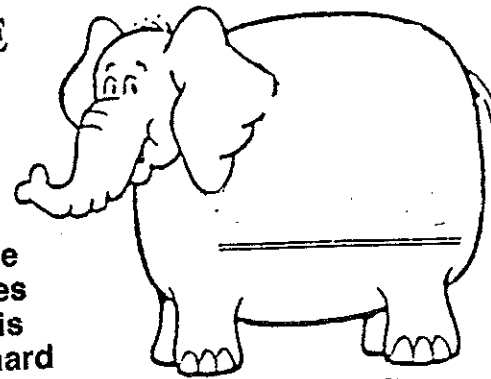
NATIONAL POSTAL MUSEUM
