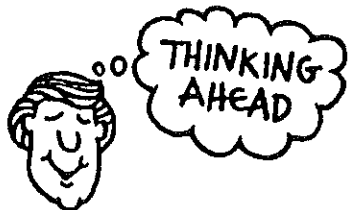

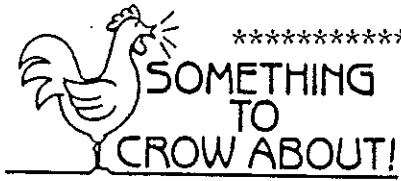

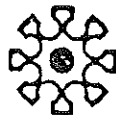
SOMETHING TO CROW ABOUT! WHITE ELEPHANT SALE
