The 1993 Quad City Stamp Club "Stamp Out Cancer Auction" brought \$2715 to the fight against the dreaded disease. Proceeds from this 16th annual event will be given equally to the Cancer Society of Rock Island County and the Cancer Society of Scott County.

- DD. Juniors only - any area

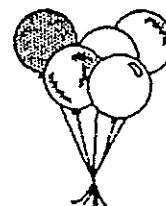

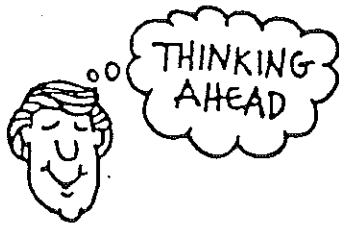
