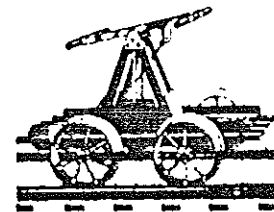
CANCER AUCTION FINAL REPORT

2. Exhibitors may enter as many different categories as desired.
3. Judging will be by popular vote or by a judging panel, as appropriate.
4. An award will be given in each category.
5. Please put your name on the back of each sheet to aid in their return.
6. If you have plastic page protectors, please use them. If not the club has some you may use.
7. Enter the exhibit the evening of May 13, prior to 7:30 p.m.

Then at the club regular meeting each month, Ray Wilden is our loyal auctioneer, and George and Jim Roberts keep close tabs on prices realized, which are then printed in the PhilaQuad. Jim usually has checks ready for the seller by the end of the meeting.
