This year seems to have an unusually large number of se-tenant issues and most of them look to your editor like seals from some inexpensive advertising gimmick.

May future issues show high grade engraving rather than gaudy cheapness!

This past winter the Quad City Stamp club donated to the National Postal Museum. As the result of this donation our club was invited to send a representative to the opening. Our member T. George Gilinsky lives in the Washington area so we asked him to represent us. In response he sent the following letter.

MEMO TO THE QUAD CITY STAMP CLUB ON THE OPENING OF THE NATIONAL POSTAL MUSEUM

I want to thank you for allowing me to attend one of the pre-opening events. I and my wife, Shirley, attended the affair on July 28, 1991. I think everyone will like the National Postal Museum. It is located in the old main postoffice just west of Union Station in Washington, DC and thus easy to reach on the Metro-subway, which stops at Union Station.

They have left the old front facade and the old public part of the post office, as they were, except that it is now cleaned up. The bulk of the museum is located in the old sorting area, which has been completely redone. There are many examples of the old airplanes that first carried airmail,--all hung from the ceiling. Also some real old stagecoaches and realistic displays. Of course there is a great vault room where some of the outstanding philatelic items are on display, such as the "upside-down airplane", as well as great displays of other stamps. One exhibit even reproduced "Notched" trees that early postriders used to find their way through the wilderness. I even played a computer game designed to show how the early airplanes flew the mail from Omaha to Iowa City--I actually could guide the old plane and follow the train tracks and land it in an old airfield.

All in all, it is a great addition to the Smithsonian Institution, and I hope that each of you will get a chance to see and use this new facility. James H. Bruns, the present Director, is to be congratulated on accomplishing such a huge task, particularly in these times. Thanks again for allowing me to use your invitation.
