Mail Service Improves in the Quad-Cities

Steve Bahnsen submitted this story from the
Midwest Area Update, a postal employee's newsletter



A series of operational changes has resulted in better mail service for the Quad-Cities area of Illinois and Iowa. The changes have resulted from cooperative efforts by employees in Bloomington, Springfield, Kankakee and Champaign, IL.

Mail coming from Bloomington, though only 140 miles away, used to take two days for delivery, because mail was sent to as many as three destinations for resorting.

Now Bloomington employees put all SCF Rock Island mail in a single separation. Existing transportation is used to get the mail to the Quad Cities overnight.

Also, Springfield, the bar code sorter now holds out both Moline and Rock Island city mail. Even though this mail does not get into Rock Island until 4:30 a.m., employees still have time to sort the mail the same morning. Overnight service is now possible from Illinois' state capital (sic).

Priority Mail service also has improved. Rock Island has routed its Priority Mail for Kankakee so it is delivered overnight, and Champaign has established a Priority Mail sack just for SCF Rock Island, changing two-day service to overnight.

"All these upgrades have been accomplished without adding any transportation," says Rock Island Plant Manager Dennis Schoening. "It just took some tweaking of our sorting procedures to result in better service for our customers."
