Deadline for entering is April 30, 1994. Entries are open to children between the ages of 8 and 13 as of April 30, 1994. Only one entry per person. The rest of the information is on the entry form which is available and any McDonalds or any Post Office. Be sure to read the rules carefully. They appear on the back of the form.

Send a stamp design which shows an activity or practice that helps protect, preserve or restore the environment, including land, air, or water. The artwork must be 'in color, using paint, crayon, marker, colored pencils or other drawing tool. Draw horizontally on an 8 1/2 X 11 piece of paper. Leave exactly a one inch margin on all sides. The design must be an original creation. You can not copy, trace or reproduce someone else's artwork. You cannot show or spell a commercial institution or person's name or likeness.

If you have any questions, call Susan Hayes 764-3068. She will help you work on this design at next month's meeting. You can send it in before if you want. The deadline is April 30, 1994.
