7. Enter the exhibit on the evening of May 12, prior to 7:30 p.m.

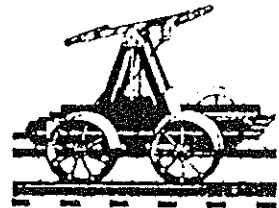

- Opening Day Cachet (Fig. 1):** A black and white line art drawing of Roberto Clemente available April 8, 1994.
- Forbes Field Cachet (Fig. 2) :** A photo of Forbes Field, former home of the Pittsburgh Pirates, where Roberto played in his first Major League game. Cachet available June 28, the last game at Forbes field.
- Roberto's Statue Cachet (Fig. 3):** A bronze-tone recreation of the Roberto Clemente Statue. Cachet available July 8, 1994, the date of the unveiling ceremony. This cachet is available on an embossed envelope for \$2.00.
- Roberto's Statue & Stamps (Fig.4)** The Roberto Clemente Statue will also be available on a 6-3/4 envelope franked with two rare 20-cent Roberto Clemente stamps (issued on Aug 17, 1984) for \$5.00. (Fig. 4)
- 60th Birthday Cachet (Fig 5) :** A photo of Roberto Clemente and his children. Available August 18, 1994. (Fig. 5)

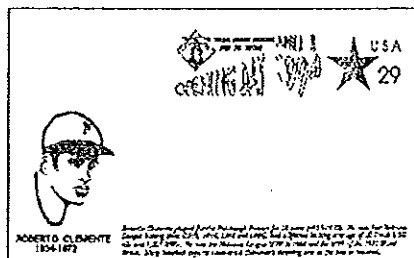

The set will included cachets of Fig1, Fig4 and Fig5. The fourth cachet will be Roberto's Statue cachet franked with three rare stamps: a 1984 20-cent Roberto Clemente stamp, a 1939 3-cent baseball stamp and a 1969 6-cent professional baseball stamp.

All orders will be acknowledged upon receipt and a number assigned to the recipient, giving authenticity as to the original collector series. These sets will be released after the Roberto Clemente Statue is unveiled on July 8, 1994.
