LEGENDS OF THE WEST: Finally the Real McCoy

When the misprinted Legends of the West stamps were recalled last January before their official public debut, the Postal Service promised to reprint them and release the new pane of 20 different 29-cent stamps later this year.

The new release date is Tuesday, October 18, with nationwide sales on Wednesday following first-day-of-issue ceremonies in Laramie, Wyo.; Tucson, Ariz.; and Lawton, Okla.

So much attention has been drawn over the past nine months to the Bill Pickett snafu, with his brother Ben portrayed on the commemorative meant for himself, that the subjects of the other 19 have been overshadowed by the hoopla.

Sixteen individuals and four western themes are showcased on the Legends of the West stamps, described by the USPS as the first releases in a series of Americana-themed adhesives to be known as the Classic Collections.

Once or twice a year, the Postal Service anticipates issuing a similar pane of 20 stamps, each featuring a different genre of subjects. The format will remain consistent with a decorative banner of selvage across the top and bright, colorful stamps in the collection.

"Artwork on the Classic Collection stamps will always be colorful and collectible, making them appealing to both the serious and casual stamp collector," Azeezaly S. Jaffer, USPS manager of Stamp Services, explained recently.

The legends of the West stamps honor a wide variety of individuals as evidence by this list:

- *Annie Oakley, frontier sharpshooter.
- *Buffalo Bill, Wild West show impressario.
- *Jim Bridger, frontiersman and explorer.
- *Chief Joseph, Nez Perce Indian tribe leader.
- *Bat Masterson, deputy sheriff in Dodge City, Kan.
- *Nellie Cashman, anti-violence peacemaker in Tombstone, Ariz.
- *John Fremont, frontier explorer and cartographer
- *Bill Tilghman, old-time Western lawman.
- *Kit Carson, fur trapper and mountain guide.
- *Bill Pickett, cowboy and inventor of bulldogging.
- *Wild Bill Hickok, federal Marshall and marksman.
- *Geronimo, Chiricahua Apache leader.
- *Charles Goodnight, Texas Ranger and pioneer cattle rancher.
- *Sacagawea, Lewis and Clark Expedition guide.
- *Wyatt Earp, playwer at the OK Corral shootout.
- *Jim Beckwourth, pioneer mountain man, fur trader and scout.

In addition to these 16 people, the four corner stamps of the Legends of the West pane each feature a different Western theme tying the series together:

- *Native American culture.
- *Western wildlife.
- *Overland mail
- *American cowboy

Add the Legends of the West classic Collection reprinted pane to your collection and to your mail starting Wednesday at USPS Philatelic Centers and larger post offices in your area. Cost of the full pane of 20 stamps is \$5.80. If you can afford them, you should buy two panes--one to keep intact, the other to carefully separate into singles. Most stamp albums will have spaces for both the full pane and the individual stamps.

A set of 20 different 19-cent postal cards depicting artwork from the corresponding Legends of the West stamps will also be released Tuesday, October 18. Cost of the set of 20 postal cards is \$7.95.

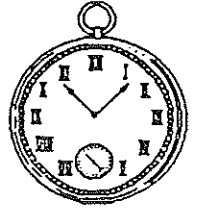
