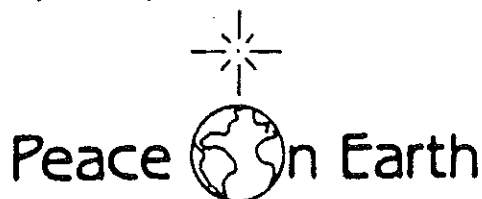
The President's Corner

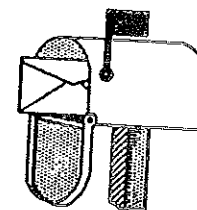

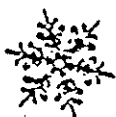
