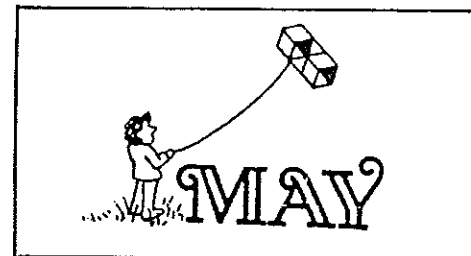

RULES

1. Not more than 2 album pages may be entered in any category, page size 10" by 11" or smaller.
2. Exhibitors may enter as many different categories as desired.
3. Judging will be by popular vote or by a judging panel, as appropriate.
4. An award will be given in each category.
5. Please put your name on the back of each sheet to aid in their return.
6. If you have plastic page protectors, please use them. If not the club has some you may use.
7. Enter the exhibit on the evening of May 11, prior to 7:30 p.m.

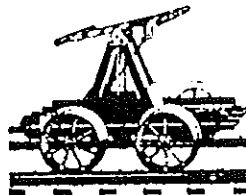
